- \* Rider age determined as of December 31, 2007
- \* Helmets are required for all riders
- \* Race officials may combine fields & adjust race distances based upon number of racers
- \* All USCF racers **MUST** have a license to race.

- \* Prize pay-outs subject to minimum field sizes of 40 riders. Promoter reserves the right to adjust pay-outs.
- \* Field limits for Men Cat 5, Women Cat 4 and Juniors will be limited to 50 riders!!!

## RACE LEADERS JERSEYS

The leaders jersey for the **2007 Tour of Kensington Valley** are presented by **Dr. Marc Rhem and the TLC Laser & Eyecare Centers of Michigan** ([www.tlceyecare.com](http://www.tlceyecare.com)). These jerseys will be awarded to the leading racer in each category at the end of each individual stage. The final jersey will be awarded the overall winner as determined by either lowest overall combined time or the highest overall points total, depending category.

The winner of each category will be presented the jersey after the road race stage on Sunday, May 20<sup>th</sup>, at the Orchard Picnic area of Kensington Metro Park.



**Leaders Jersey Rules:** The individual racer that is in the lead (based on either lowest overall combined time or the highest overall points total, depending category) will be required to wear the leaders jersey in the next stage. Immediately after the conclusion of the stage, the leader will be required to return the jersey, which will then be presented to the new overall race leader.

The final overall leader and race winner will be allowed to keep the jersey.

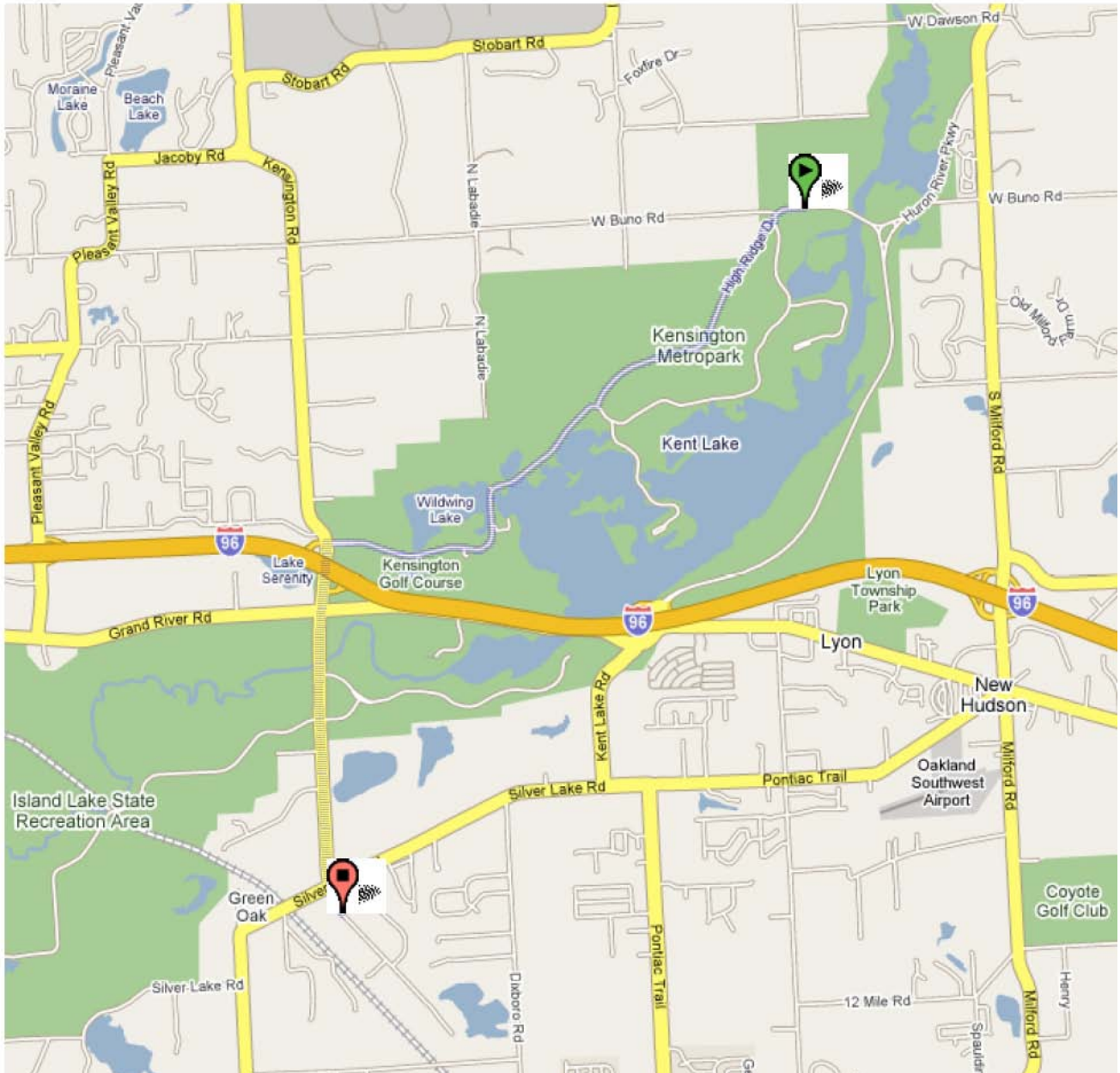


## Map / Directions from Kensington Metro Park to Stage 2 Criterium Course
